General WIL/Internship Description

Practera (a company that delivers technology-enabled experiential learning to prepare global learners for the future of work) has partnered with WACE to bring you a Global Challenge which is an interdisciplinary Student Collaborative Project. This is a 3-week virtual programme where teams of students from around the globe will work collaboratively to solve a real industry challenge for a Start-up, SME Business or a Non-profit organisation. Successful candidates will take part in a shared value business strategy which aims to solve social issues and profitability, increased competitiveness and economic growth for the company and better economic & social conditions for the communities in which it operates.

Other Requirements

Successful candidates should have interests in global collaboration, intercultural communication, self-direction and an independent worker, a problem solver, willing to learn, pay attention to detail, flexibility to engage with people in different time zones, report writing, have secured internet connection, be pro-active and should be dedicated to completing the project.
